### Step 1

You can use your laptop or smartphone for ease of completion. Just like in our regular survey, for most questions, if you would prefer not to answer a question you can skip it.



The **young adult** survey, for participants aged between 20 and 26 years, will take around 10 to 15 minutes to complete.



The **parent/guardian** survey will take around 5 minutes to complete.

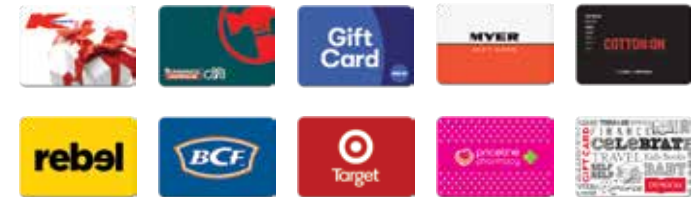
### Step 2
